








Dependency

Reliance on the functionality provided by some other external component

Interdependency

A mutual dependence, connection or correlation

Vulnerability

The inability of people, organizations, systems and societies to withstand adverse impacts from multiple stressors to which they are exposed

Resilience

The mental ability to recover quickly from depression, illness or misfortune

The physical property of material that can resume its shape after being stretched or deformed; elasticity


The positive ability of a system or organization to adapt itself to the consequences of a catastrophic failure caused by power outage, a fire, a bomb or similar

Resilience (Rieger*)

A resilient control system is one that maintains state awareness and an accepted level of operational normalcy in response to disturbances, including threats of an unexpected and malicious nature.
